ARTIST: Alan Honn, Center City

Al is Swedish on his mother's side of the family. He is the proprietor of Al's Center Saloon in Center City and is also a glassblower with over 30 years of experience. Al earned his BFA at the University of Minnesota and practiced his craft in Colorado and Washington before returning home to Minnesota. Currently, he is a studio artist and teacher at Foci-Minnesota Center for Glass Arts in Minneapolis. Form is the artist’s primary consideration; he often works with clear glass, focusing on surface reflections and interior views to create sculptural, functional goblets, pilsners, vases and bowls. Al’s design for the Old Swedish Quilt Trail reflects this work.
